I love Thanksgiving. It's a time to revel in family. A number of years ago, after my father died, I realized I knew nothing of his earlier family. I used Ancestry.com and found there were Allens who were farmers in the southern part of our county. One thing led to another, and I got a call from a man living outside Washington, DC. He started our conversation with "Hello cousin." He had recently visited Lewis County and was reaching out to Allens he knew were relatives.

He told me, "I was enjoying an early cup of coffee at Café Z and was watching Lowville walk by. He said, "Little did I realize that just down the street was the last living Allen relation in Lowville, sitting at his desk as editor of the weekly newspaper. We connected via Ancestry.com.
